Timber provides a hardwearing and long lasting surface, adding natural character, style and warmth to any setting. Whether in the home or a commercial environment, solid wood work surfaces offer the ultimate in luxury, versatility and beauty. As a practical choice for kitchen worktops, hardwoods are extremely hygienic, hardwearing and long lasting, with a timeless appeal in either a traditional or contemporary setting. All work surfaces are forested from a sustainable source.

Crafted to last

All raw material is sorted manually and subjected to an ongoing quality control process during the seasoning and pre-machining phase. Every length of wood is measured for moisture content to make sure that the product quality remains consistent every time.

Recognised as one of the best hardwood worksurfaces in the market all are constructed from highly engineered finger jointed staves. Each solid hardwood stave is 41.5mm wide and is matched by hand prior to being glued together to the highest DIN standards and crafted to ensure maximum strength, providing a lifetime of service in today's fast moving kitchen.

SOLID WOOD Kitchen Worktops

Solid hardwood kitchen worktops provide a natural beauty that is hard to beat, no other form of kitchen work surface has the timeless beauty and warmth that a real solid wood worktop brings to the kitchen.

One of the main advantages of a solid wood worktop is that while other work surfaces tend to age badly through use, wood gains in character, often becoming richer and deeper in colour over time. Equally it has the benefit of being solid all the way through allowing any surface damage or scratches to be easily sanded away to reveal a fresh new surface.



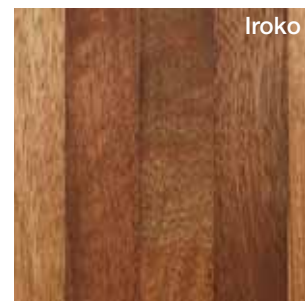
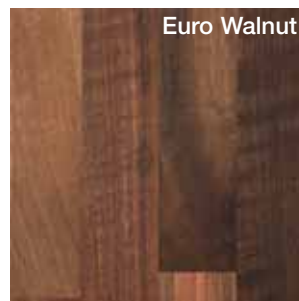
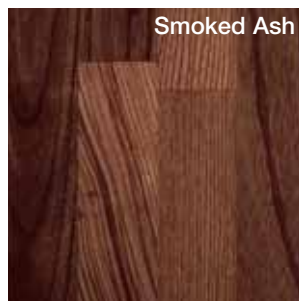
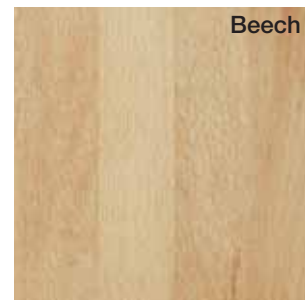
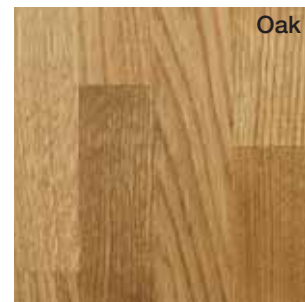
Accessories

Work Surfaces

The best finish for a solid wood work surface is oil. Oil adds depth and character to the wood that varnish and lacquers can't match, it is also simple to apply and easy to resurface should the worktop become tired looking and gives the wood a water resistant finish.

All solid wood work surfaces are supplied with comprehensive Installation Guidelines.

Storage

Always store flat on a fully supported surface. If stored for a long duration turn occasionally.

Installation and Maintenance

Before installation it is recommended to oil all the surfaces with a high quality oil, such as Danish oil. At least two coats of oil are needed on the underside and the edges that will not be seen, this is to balance the worktop and stop it from bowing. The top and front sides should receive 3 to 5 light coats, with a very light sanding in between to form a very tough seal and enhance the natural colours. Extra care should be taken around taps and areas of heavy use or exposure.

During installation a 4 mm gap is required between the work surface and the wall for natural expansion of the wood. A small gap is also necessary around taps, pipes, sinks etc. to allow for movement and expansion.

After fitting, oil about once a week for the first few months and then re-apply at 2-3 month intervals or once the surface starts to appear dull.



Cleaning

The work surface can be easily cleaned with a mild solution of water and washing-up liquid.

Recommendations

Hot pans should not be placed directly onto the work surface.

Always use a cutting board to chop food. Do not cut directly on the worktop.

Do not allow liquids to stand for any length of time, always mop up spills of water and other liquids straight away.

Contact

Solid Wood Work Surfaces are manufactured to stringent quality control procedures. As they are natural products there will be variations in colour and knot formation. The Work Surfaces are supplied untreated with oil and the company cannot be held responsible for any subsequent installation and treatment.
